Mission Statement

As a life-centered treatment program, Flip the Script’s primary mission is to provide a full continuum of treatment and related services for individuals, their families and significant others who are suffering from chemical dependency related issues. Our mission is to make our services available to patients with significant legal involvement and those who lack adequate/consistent housing.

- Chemical dependency is a primary disease and that total abstinence from alcohol and other mind-altering intoxicants is essential to recovery.
- Society and individuals benefit most from the earliest possible intervention.
- Chemical dependency is a family illness and an effective treatment program must encompass the entire family, which will include intensive case-management services to better acclimate the patient back into the work force/society and increase the patient’s market value in the workforce. .
- Raising the level of community awareness about alcohol/drug abuse is an essential part of our mission.
